BRIDGE ON 105TH - The old bridge and trees around the bridge have been removed due to the Northern long-eared brown bats. This bat is endangered so if nests are found around the work area, no work can be done from April 1st through October 31st. Bids for the bridge project are due back to the County by the end of March, so we will have a better idea as to when construction on the new bridge will begin and the projected completion time.

NO PARKING ON EDUCATION DRIVE – Due to the amount of traffic coming and going from our school, signs are being made for: "NO PARKING FROM 7:30 A.M. TILL 4:30 P.M. WHILE SHOOL IS IN SESSISON." Signs will be posted once we receive them. Enforce begins immediately.

<u>CHICKENS</u> – are allowed in the Village limits as of December 7, 2022. Ordinance 2022-06 states three (3) hens per household with a \$25.00 fee per household per year. Ordinance and codes can be found on the website at Malcolm.ne.gov. An application for chickens can be found on the website.

MALCOLM CLEAN UP DAY – May 6th, 2023 – ONE MONTH AWAY!! Hours are 8:00 am. – 4:30 p.m. dumpsters will be located at 300 South Exeter Street (In front of the Maintenance Building). Please **DO NOT** place anything in the dumpsters before the dumpsters are marked at 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning. The Village can save a lot of money on dumping fees if we can keep certain items divided. We will also be collecting:

<u>GOODWILL DONATION</u> – The Goodwill truck will be onsite at 3:00 sharp, please have your items at the cleanup site by 2:30 p.m.

OLD TIRES - A trailer will be at the site for passenger vehicle tires only or small trailer tires -

No truck tires or tractor tires will be accepted. Tires with concrete or dirt in the tires will NOT be accepted. Trailer will be available from 8:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.

<u>**BATTERIES**</u> – Automotive batteries and lawn equipment batteries that are not broken or leaking will be accepted this year.

2022 ANNUAL WATER QUALITY REPORT – A copy of the Annual Water Quality Report from the Department of Health and Human Services is posted at the Village Hall Post Office and Fire & Rescue Building and on the Malcolm website for your review. This report is intended to provide you with important information about your drinking water and the efforts made by the Village of Malcolm water system to provide safe drinking water. DOG LICENSE APPLICATIONS – Enclosed is a dog license application form which needs to be filled out and returned to the Village Hall <u>by JUNE 1, 2023</u>. All dog(s) are required to be licensed through the Malcolm Village Office, and a non-returnable copy of a certificate of vaccination with the date (s) of the rabies vaccination needs to be submitted with the renewal application.

<u>AGING PARTNERS</u> – Meets at the Village Hall the third Friday of each month from 9:00 A.M. – 11:00 a.m. See enclosed handout to learn more about it.

BUILDING PERMITS – All residents living within the Village limits and/or within the one-mile jurisdiction of the Village of Malcolm are required to apply for a building permit through the Malcolm Village Office for ALL PROJECTS. Building permit forms as well as the Malcolm Municipal Code can be found on our website at www.Malcolm.ne.gov. Chapter 9 informs you of which projects need a building permit and which projects are exempt from a building permit. Chapter 12 informs you of the Zoning Regulations and setbacks required for your project(s).

MALCOLM FARMER'S MARKET – The 2nd year of the Farmer's Market is under way. The Market is held in the parking lot of St. Paul's Lutheran Church on Saturday mornings from 8:00 a.m. – 11:00 a.m.

OTHER REMINDERS -

- Vehicles, trailers, boats, campers.... are NOT allowed to be parked on the streets for over a 24hour period, per Code 4-302, vehicles, trailers boats, campers.... will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Tree's bushes, shrubs and weeds need to be kept trimmed back and away from all sidewalks, streets, and alleyways.
- Parking over sidewalks or between the sidewalk and street is not allowed, vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.
- The 19th Malcolm Auto Show will be held on August 20, 2023, in the park.
- <u>Food Trucks</u> within the Village limits are required to complete a Mobile Food Vendors application and submit to the Village Office <u>BEFORE</u> the food truck is allowed to set up, attachments must be included with the application. Applications and codes can be found on the Malcolm website – Malcolm.ne.gov.
- <u>GOLF CARTS</u> Just a friendly reminder, Chapter 5, Article 3, Section 5-304 defines where, when, and who can operate golf carts, ATV's or any other off-highway vehicles, and tells the age the driver needs to be to operate them on the streets in Malcolm.
- Remember if you want a good book to read you don't have to go far. The two <u>little libraries</u> we have in the Village are constantly getting new books in them. One is located on the porch of the Village Hall and the other is located at the crosswalk in front of Westfall School.

Village Board meetings as well as the Planning Commission meetings are opened to the public, your input is very important to the continued growth and everyday concerns of the Village. The Board cannot help with any problems that might arise within the Village unless you bring the problems or concerns to the Board.
