<u>Malcolm Clean Up day</u> – will be held on April 16<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. till 4:30 p.m. at 300 South Exeter Street, (Maintenance Shop). Please <u>do not</u> place anything in the dumpsters before the dumpsters are marked at 8:00 a.m. on Saturday, April 16<sup>th</sup>. The Village can save a lot of money on dumping fees if we can keep certain items divided. A Goodwill Truck and a trailer for tires will be onsite at the same time, see below:

**GOODWILL DONATION** – See enclosed flyer as to what will be accepted and what will not be accepted. Items can be dropped off between 8:00 a.m. – 2:30 p.m. only!

<u>TIRE TRAILER</u> – A trailer will be at the site for passenger vehicle tires only or small trailer tires, no truck tires or tractor tires will be accepted. Trailer will be available from 8:00 a.m. till 3:30 p.m. only.

<u>BATTERIES</u> – Automotive batteries and lawn equipment batteries not broken or leaking will be accepted this year.

**IDENTIFICATION OF LEAD AND COOPER WATER LINES** - Due to the Lead and Cooper statutes with the State of Nebraska, the Department of Environment and Energy is making it a requirement that all Water operators determine the material that residential homes have for the water service line coming into their homes. Please see the enclosed brochure for more details or call Don Schrader at (308) 882-1505 for additional questions. **There is a form on the brochure that is enclosed that needs to be completed and returned with your water bill that is due on April 20<sup>th</sup>.** 

<u>AGING PARTNERS</u> – The first meeting of the Aging Partners Resource Events was held Friday, March 18<sup>th</sup>. It was an Introduction to Aging Partners. <u>LATE FEE'S FOR WATER/SEWER PAYMENTS</u> - In the February 7, 2022, residential letter the effective date for the increase in the late fees for water/sewer payments was incorrect. The increase from \$12.50 to \$25.00 will begin May 1<sup>st</sup> not March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

<u>DOG LICENSE APPLICATIONS</u> – Enclosed is a dog license application form which needs to be filled out and returned to the Village Hall by <u>June 1, 2022</u>. All dog(s) are required to be licensed through the Malcolm Village Office, and a non-returnable copy of a certificate of vaccination with the date(s) of the rabies vaccination needs to be submitted with the renewal application.

<u>MALCOLM GARAGE SALES</u> – will be held on June 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. For more information visit the Malcolm Families Facebook page.

<u>PROTECT YOUR SEWER - PROTECT YOUR ENVIRONMENT</u> - Under the state health regulations, public water suppliers are required to send the enclosed pamphlets at least once a year regarding cross connection, back flow prevention or sewer issues. If you have any questions, please call the Village Office.

**FOOD TRUCKS** – Just a friendly reminder, as of January 1, 2021, all food trucks within the village limits are required to complete a Mobile Food Vendors application and submit to the Village Office before the Food Truck is allowed to set up, attachments must be included with the application.
