BACKGROUND: Ordinance 2022-06 Ordinance regarding Chickens in the Village limits:

Little made a motion to suspend the three-reading rule for Ordinance 2022-06. Faubion seconded the motion. The Chairperson called for the vote recorded as follows: AYE: Little, Schweitzer, Tarr, Faubion, Lemkau: NAY: None; Motion carried 5-0.

Following the reading of Ordinance 2022-06, Little made a motion to approve Ordinance 2022-06 to allow 3 hens per household within the Village limits. Faubion seconded the motion.
