JUST A FEW REMINDERS!!

Snow Policies

- Remove vehicles from the street to allow the snowplow to plow the entire road
- Do not park directly across from another vehicle, it is difficult to get the snowplow and sand/salt truck between the vehicles. It is also a safety concern for emergency vehicles to get through.'
- ALL sidewalks need to be cleared within five (5) hours after the cessation of a storm, per Code 8-203
- If you have a fire hydrant nearby, please help by scooping around it to make it easier and faster for the Fire Department to hook on if need.

The Village policy for snow removal is as follows: Plowing will begin once there is 3" of snow on the ground. Please remember, it may take a while to get from one end of the town to the other, but plowing will begin once 3" accumulates on the roads.

OTHER REMINDERS

- Vehicles are not allowed to be parked on the streets for over a 24-hour period, per Code 4-302, vehicles will be towed at owner's expense.
- Malcolm Clean Up Day is scheduled for May 6, 2023.
- If you live within the Village limits or within the one-mile radius of the Village, all building permits need to be submitted to the Malcolm Village Office, projects that are exempt from a building permit can be found in Chapter 9 of the Code Book.
- Tree's bushes, shrubs and weeds are to be kept trimmed back and away from all sidewalks, streets, and alleyways.
- All dogs need to be licensed through the Malcolm Village Office, and a current rabies vaccination needs to be always on file.
- Parking over sidewalks or between the sidewalk and street is not allowed, vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

Village Board meetings as well as the Planning Commission meetings are opened to the public, your input is very important to the continued growth and everyday concerns of the Village. The Board cannot help with any problems that might arise within the Village unless you bring the problems or concerns to the Board. The Village Board meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month, beginning at 7:00 p.m. The Malcolm Planning Commission meetings are held on the last Wednesday of each month, beginning at 7:00 p.m. Both meetings are held at the Village Hall located at 137 E. 2nd Street, Malcolm, NE.
