APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Little made a motion to accept the minutes of the December 7, 2022, meeting, seconded by Tarr. The Chairperson called for the vote recorded as follows: AYE: Little, Tarr, Faubion, Lemkau; NAY: None; Motion carried 4–0; Members absent: Schweitzer.

TREASURER REPORT – Little made a motion to accept the treasurer's report for the month of December 2022, with disbursements of \$156,680.17 and deposits of \$172,169.05. Motion seconded by Lemkau. Todd Speth with Municipal Supply Inc. was present to show the new types of remote water meters Municipal Supply has to offer and to provide a quote for the new system.

Jon Mohr and Jared Ritze with the Malcolm Planning Commission were present to further discuss adding Ag Residential to the Malcolm Municipal Code.

After further discussion, Board recommends that the Planning Commission draft a proposed AG Residential code and present to the Board when finished.

BACKGROUND: Update Employee's Manual: Tabled until next month.

BACKGROUND: Trade-in for a newer Maintenance Truck/Dump Truck: Still in search of a truck that will blade and spread sand/salt at the same time.

BACKGROUND: Contract/Agreement with Miller & Associates for the Water Model Project: A Professional Services Agreement between the Village of Malcolm and Consultants of Miller & Associates, Consulting Engineers, P.C., to provide professional consulting services related to the preparation of Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Project, Planning Activities and Report for a public water supply drinking water improvement project grant, that was awarded on October 26, 2022 for \$20,000.00 was reviewed and signed.

BACKGROUND: Contract/Agreement with Miller & Associates for the GIS Mapping Project: An Agreement for the Provision of Limited Professional Services between the Village of Malcolm and Miller & Associates Consulting Engineers, P.C. for a GIS Mapping - Water Infrastructure Map. Grant was approved by Nebraska Department of Environment and Energy October 25, 2022 for \$4,000.00. Agreement was reviewed and signed.

BACKGROUND: Sparq Meetings subscription Dues for April 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024: Subscription dues for \$3,500.00 for the 2023 fiscal year starting April 1, 2023 – March 31, 2024. Next year Sparq will be doing away with Tier 1 which is what the Village is at, so prices will be going up to \$4,100.00 or higher for 2024 fiscal year.
