**Dog Renewals** – Just a friendly reminder any person who shall own, keep, or harbor a dog within the Village within thirty (30) days after acquisition of the said dog shall acquire a license for each such dog annually by or before the first (1<sup>st</sup>) day of June of each year. The village board & the village clerk have received various informal complaints about differing topics surrounding our community & its residents. Some of the key areas of feedback have centered on the following topics:

- Pet Ownership
  - If you take on the responsibility of owning a dog, it must be licensed and maintain current rabies vaccinations.
  - Cleaning up after your pet during walks
  - Ensuring your pet is properly fenced during the day to avoid them escaping and running around town, requiring others to chase down and return them to your home.
- Yard Maintenance
  - When mowing your yard, find a proper place to dispose of your clippings. <u>Clippings</u> should not be sprayed or dumped into the street. This is dangerous for motorcycles, bikes and kids trying to stop turn or maneuver. It can also lead to clogged storm sewers and cause grass to start growing in the streets.
- Golf Carts and ATV's
  - Ensuring all proper state and local codes are followed and, that no golf carts are driven on any sidewalks within the Village

• Keeping a clear sidewalk for pedestrians to walk on, i.e. vehicles, grass clippings, hedges, tree branches.

**Board Members Needed!** The Malcolm Village Board of Trustees will have two openings coming up on the election in November 2022. Trustees are elected to a four-year term; meetings are held on the first Wednesday of each month; with a begin time at 7:00 p.m.; you must live within the Village limits to be able to run for a seat on the Board.
