VILLAGE WEBSITE - Check out the Village's new website at Malcolm.ne.gov. When you get to the site click on "Subscribe to Receive News & Alerts via Text and/or Email!" at the very top. Enter your name and phone or email address to receive text messages or emails to stay updated as to what is happening in Malcolm, as far as water main breaks, street closures or repairs, when the bridge on 105th will be completed and anything else that happens in Malcolm.

CHICKENS - At the September 6, 2023, Village Board Meeting, the Board approved Ordinance 2023-06, which allows 6 chickens instead of 3 chickens which the original Ordinance allowed.

Please remember that if you own chickens or dogs, they need to be licensed through the Village Office. Dogs also need a certificate of Rabies Vaccinations to submit with the dog application.

HAZARDOUS WASTE COLLECTION EVENTS - If you have any hazardous waste that you would like to get rid of safely, Lincoln's Hazardous Waste Center will have a collection event on Friday, October 6 from 2-6 p.m. at the Raymond Fire Station located at 410 West Raymond Road in Raymond or a collection event will be held on Saturday, October 7 from 9 a.m. – 1 p.m. located at 4375 South 33rd Ct., in Lincoln. BRIDGE – As you can see the bridge is being built on 105th, anticipated completion date is March 2024 depending on winter weather conditions.

BUILDING PERMITS – All residents living within the Village limits and/or within the one-mile jurisdiction of the Village of Malcolm are required to apply for a building permit through the Malcolm Village Office for ALL PROJECTS. Building permit forms as well as the Malcolm Municipal Code can be found on our website at Malcolm.ne.gov. Chapter 9 informs you of which projects need a building permit and which projects are exempt from a building permit. Chapter 12 informs you of the Zoning Regulations and setbacks required for your project(s).
