- The well being drilled within the one-mile jurisdiction of Malcolm is a domestic well only and will **NOT** be used for irrigation.
- If the well drilled pumps more than 50 gallons per minute you must obtain a permit from the Lower Platte South NRD, with a copy submitted to the Village of Malcolm.
- A site map with the location of the well, needs to be submitted.
- A \$50.00 permit fee along with the permit application can be mailed to Village of Malcolm, PO Box 228, Malcolm, NE 68402.
- This permit does not register the water well with the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources. All water wells are required to be registered by the water well contractor constructing the well with the Nebraska Department of Natural Resources within 60 days after the water well is completed pursuant to \$46-602.
- A replacement water well is one which replaces an abandoned water well that has been operated within the last three years and is constructed to provide water for the same tract of land as the abandoned water well which is being replaced. Water wells **DO** need a permit from the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District. If a water well is being replaced it must be properly abandoned according to state guidelines. A copy of those guidelines is available from the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District.
- If the water well is not constructed and equipped within a one-year period from the date of approval, a new water well permit is required.
- Water well applications are required prior to completing construction and use of the water, if construction and use of the water well is commenced prior to obtaining a permit, a late permit must be obtained from the Village with a \$250.00 application fee.
